Dear Mr. Margolin:

This is our final initial release determination to your Freedom of Information Act request, dated December 15, 2009, subject: *FOIA Request – Take 2*.

We have conducted a search of the office specifically responsible for 'patent infringements'; which is our Office of General Counsel. Even though you posed your request for agency records as questions, under the FOIA, federal agencies are provided guidance "that they are not required to answer questions posed as FOIA requests."

However, in an affirmative action towards seeking the records to your request we conducted a search which could answer those questions.ⁱⁱ

- Question #1: can be answered by providing you a copy of the log the Office of General Counsel maintains.
- Questions # 2-8 and 10: found 'no records', which would specifically provide you with a responsive answer to your questions.
- Question # 9: is seeking records not kept or maintained by this agency. However, you may wish to contact the General Accounting Office, which could have records relating to that specific question. The following is a link to their agency's FOIA office.

Your appeal must be addressed to: Administrator, National Aeronautics and Space Administration, Mail Stop: 9Q42, 300 E Street, SW, Washington, DC 20546, and be identified clearly on the envelope and in the letter as an "Appeal under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). Also, include a copy of the request for the agency record, and a copy of the adverse initial determination and state, to the extent possible, the reasons why you believe the initial determination should be reversed. This must be sent to the Administrator with thirty (30) calendar days of the date of the receipt of this initial determination.
