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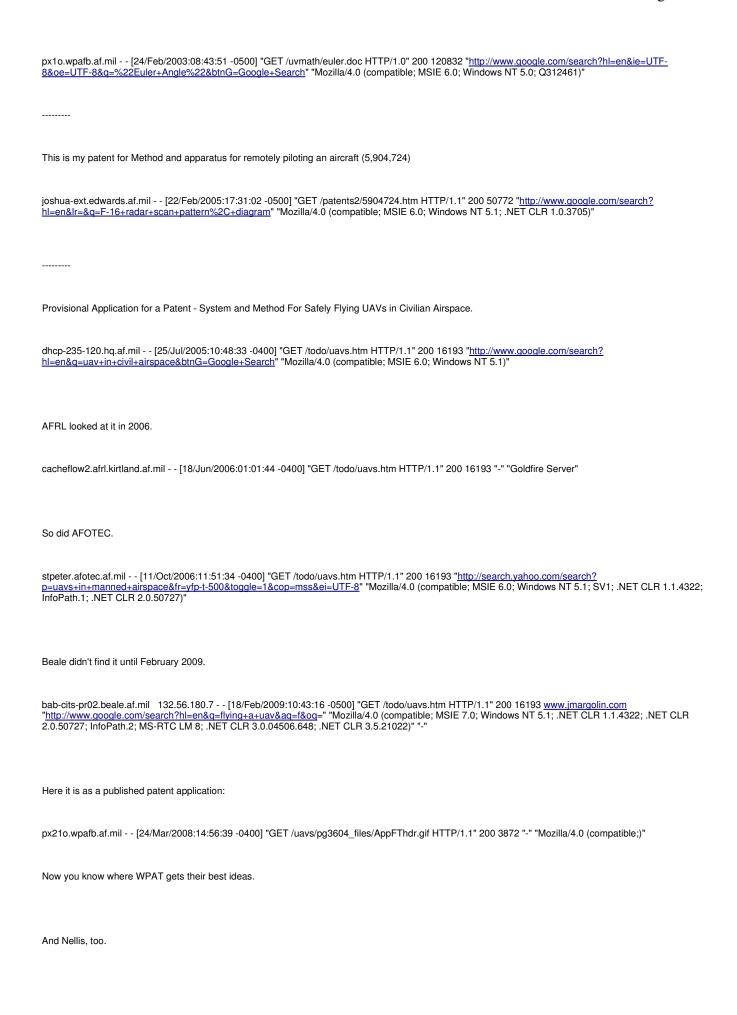

I see a pattern here of USAF becoming more obstructive with time. Perhaps this is retribution for the article/blog on my Web site where I am writing about my experiences using the Freedom of Information Act at USAF. (You admit to visiting my Web site.)

Or, perhaps I am getting closer to USAF's use of synthetic vision and you do not want to admit you are using it.

Your request for fees is denied.

Since you have denied my Appeal of your denial of my request for a fee waiver please do the following:

- 1. Confirm that I have exhausted all the administrative remedies that USAF has to offer.
